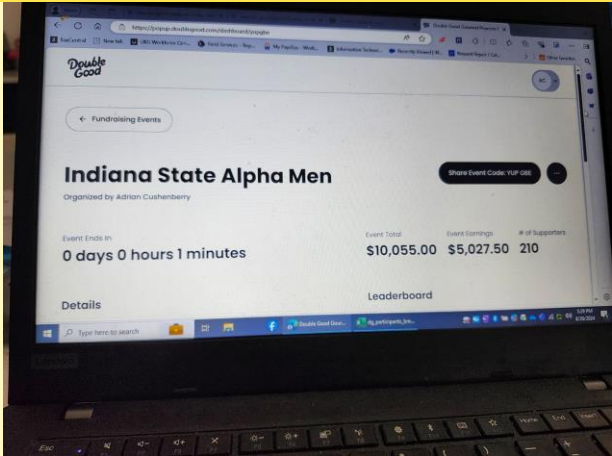

13-Sep

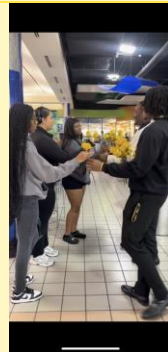
Voters 101
